SEPTEMBER GUESTS AT CANNES BRÛLEE NATIVE AMERICAN MUSEUM

The Cannes Brûlée Native American Museum will feature two guest artists during September.

On Saturday, September 6, from 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m., Lora Ann Chaisson, with the United Houma Nation, will demonstrate how she creates Native American beadwork. Those who purchase tickets to Grandparent's Day in Rivertown will also be admitted to the Native American Museum.

The following Saturday, September 13, from 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m., Scarlett and John Darden, of the Chitimacha tribe, will demonstrate their split river cane basketry. Mr. and Mrs. Darden are two of only four people who weave these traditional baskets in their tribe.

Tickets can be purchased at the Exhibition Hall located at 415 Williams Boulevard in Rivertown. The cost for entrance is \$3.00 for adults and \$2.50 for seniors and children. For more information please call the Cannes Brûlée Native American Museum at 504-468-7231.
